



## Bike ride - Montastruc

distance: 35 km - height difference: 125 m - to climb: 602 m departure: camping Charmant - gpx: ft-Montastruc-35km





- You leave the campsite via the Lindelaan (Note: this is not the main entrance!) turn right at the asphalt left at the junction (still asphalt for a while, later you follow a grass path along the Tolzac river) turn left
  at the small bridge.
- 2. Junction D210 direction Coulx (straight ahead for 2km) at the junction (at the Bernifau house) turn left towards Beaulieu at the 1st junction (at the sign le Mirail) keep right at the junction at le Mirail go straight ahead.
- 3. At the stop sign turn right D160 towards Coulx 1st asphalt road on the left towards Caillou.
- 4. At Gigan, cross the D667 towards Labourdelle T-junction at the traffic sign, turn right (D113). T-junction, turn left on the D256 to Montastruc.
- 5. At the junction at C1, turn left towards Tombeboeuf turn right at the yellow post box (towards Tombeboeuf) at the junction, turn right towards Cabannes (on the right <u>ignore</u> the junction towards Grand Rieu) a little further on, at the junction, turn left towards Brouilleau.
- 6. T-junction at the traffic sign, turn left 50 meters further on, turn right (Le Roc) junction at the Combraille sign, turn right (ignore right towards Joinis and left towards Belair) T-junction, turn left towards Villebramar.
- 7. At the junction, turn left towards Miramont and continue on the G D275 until the STOP.
- 8. Turn left towards Tourtrès (D254) intersection, turn left (towards Gite De Vinces) turn right at the stop sign immediately left at the traffic lights, D120 towards Verteuil-d'Agenais straight ahead at the roundabout towards Verteuil d'Agenais D120 take the first paved road on the left (at the sign for "Promenade et Rondonnees") follow the bend to the right and descend to the left junction, turn right (at the blue and white arrow).
- 9. T-junction at the church of Brech, turn right T-junction left towards Verteuil d'Agenais to the campsite.
